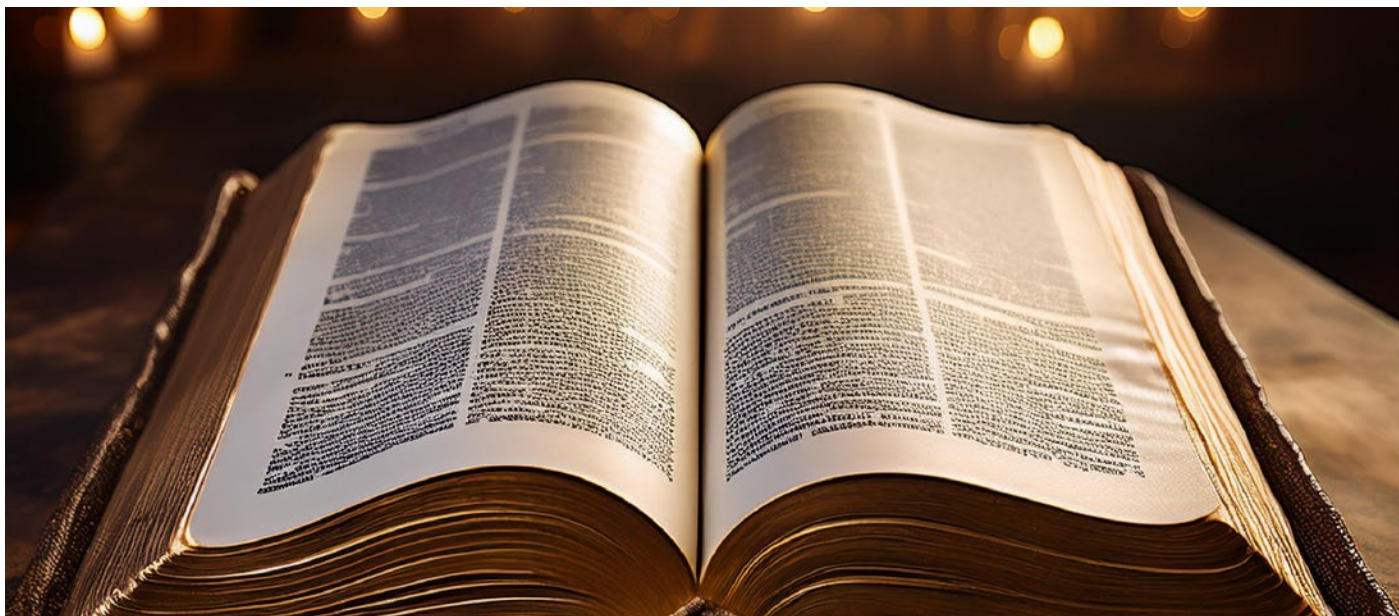

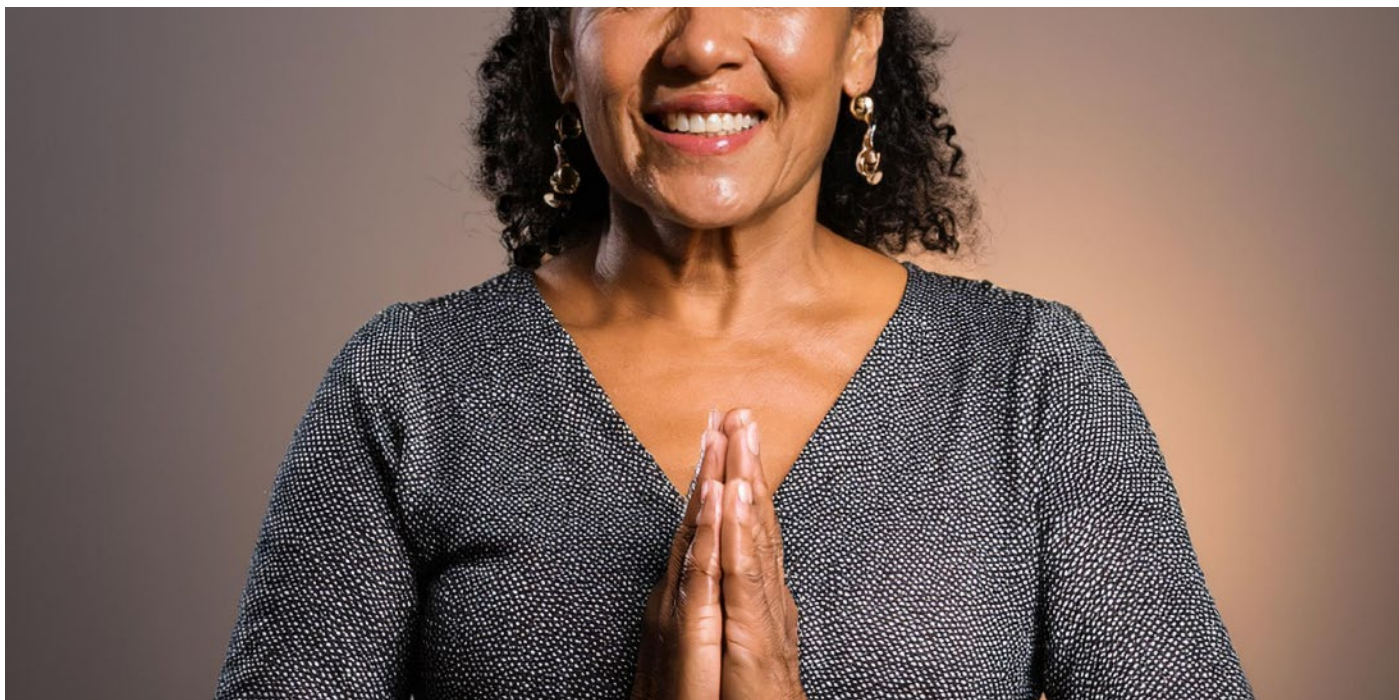

Chapter 4: The Truth About Faith and Physical Objects

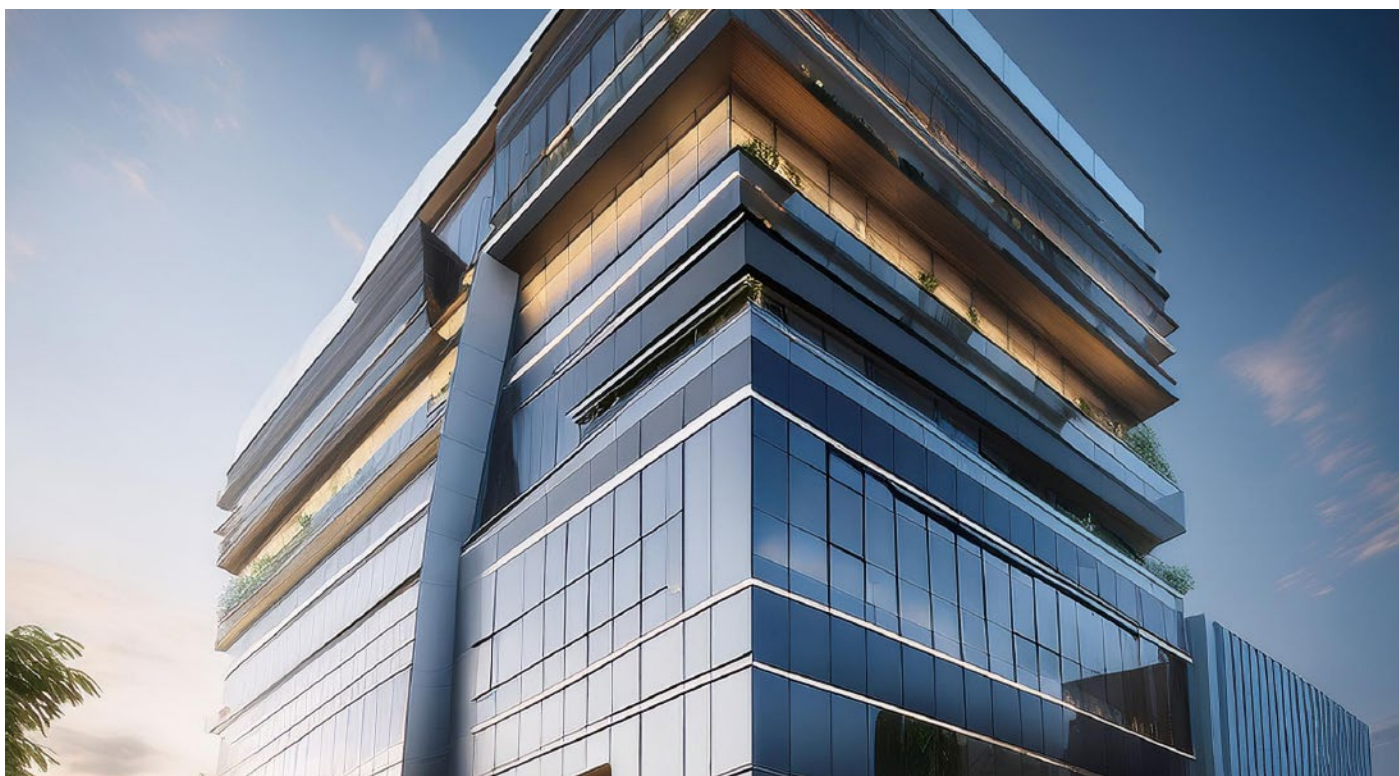

This is the truth that many ministries do not fully reveal. They may encourage the use of anointed objects without explaining that it is your belief in God's power that brings results—not the object alone. When you understand this, you are set free from relying solely on these items for your miracles.
